

Environmental Management Policy

Engenco Limited and its subsidiaries (the Company) is committed to conducting business in a manner that will help improve and protect the environment from the potential impacts of our activities. We will engage with all stakeholders, including our customers and the wider community, to work together to provide environmentally responsible and sustainable practices in the way we manage our work activities to support our commitment to the environment.

To assist in achieving those goals the Company will:

- Maintain and continually improve the Environmental Management System aligned with the elements and principles of AS/NZS ISO 14001.
- Foster a culture where employees, contractors and visitors understand their responsibilities and our expectations for caring for the environment.
- Require the efficient use of energy and materials while promoting waste reduction through re-use and recycling programs across all business activities.
- Minimise all emissions as far as reasonably practicable, and that responsible waste disposal methods are conducted.
- Require ethical environmental practice and behavior of our employees and contractors and be fully aware of potential impacts to the environment.
- Comply with and monitor developments of prescribed statutory legislative requirements including Acts, regulations, standards, codes of practice.
- Integrate environmental considerations and customer requirements into decision making, process planning, risk management and relative document development to mitigate environmental risks.
- Promote environmental awareness and responsibilities to all employees, contractors and visitors through induction, education and training.
- Regularly monitor, audit and review the companies' environmental performance and system documentation to gauge compliance and promote continual improvement.

This policy is applicable to all Business Units within the Engenco Group.

All employees, contractors and visitors are made aware of this policy and are required to comply, failure to do so will be considered a breach and may result in disciplinary action.
